- Grammar: Modal verbs: can/could, must/mustn't, have to/don't have to. Make/let.
- Speaking: explaining rules.
- Vocabulary: Sports and sport equipment. Play, do, go with sports.
- Reading strategies: watching pictures, reading the title, skimming and scanning.
- Study tips: How to remember vocabulary.
- Readings: *When sport gets dirty, Women's Football – Where Now?, E-sports: the end of sport as we know it?*
- Video: *We're the Superhumans, Sport in the UK, How playing sports benefits your body...and your brain*

- Grammar: Present Perfect: affirmative, negative, interrogative form. Present Perfect vs Past Simple. Have been vs have gone. Present Perfect with ever, never, just, already, yet, for, since. Defining relative clauses.
- Writing: How to write a review.
- Vocabulary: Adjectives of personality. Literary genres and literary idioms.
- Readings: *Cyberbullying: the shocking facts, Populations on the move.*

**Once Upon a Time**

- Grammar: Past Continuous: affirmative, negative, interrogative form. Past Continuous vs Past Simple. Used to/would.
- Writing: How to write an essay.
- Study tips: How to use a dictionary.
- Readings: *Dracula* (from Chapter 3)

## **Freak Weather**

- **Grammar:** Past Perfect: affirmative, negative, interrogative form, meaning and use. Indefinite pronouns. Zero, first and second conditional. Future: will, be going to, present continuous, present simple.
- **Speaking:** having a discussion: how to agree/disagree, how to interrupt politely, how to ask for explanations.
- **Vocabulary:** crime and criminals. Phrasal verbs about crime. Weather idioms.
- **Writing:** How to write a summary.
- **Study tips:** How to find topic sentences. How to rewrite sentences.
- **Readings:** *Old Wives's Tales, New City Dwellers, Describing a process, Opinions on Global Warming.*
- **Critical thinking:** Global warming.
- **Video:** *Can science fiction predict the future?*

## **Health**

- **Grammar:** Should, ought to, had better. Third conditional: form and use. English morphology: prefixes and suffixes. Wish and past tenses.
- **Speaking:** asking for and giving advice.
- **Vocabulary:** parts of the body, illnesses, injuries and remedies, medical collocations.
- **Readings:** *Save Our Health Service!, Voting With Our Feet, A Life Less Ordinary.*

## **Pure Genius!**

- **Grammar:** the passive: present simple, past simple, present perfect. Order of adjectives.
- **Speaking:** describing objects.
- **Vocabulary:** collocations with make and do.
- **Writing:** how to write a formal letter.
- **Readings:** *Designing the Future.*

- **Grammar:** reported speech.
- **Speaking:** gossiping.
